New Business

SURPLUS PROPERTY

City Manager Ed Moon stated there were no changes from the last work session. The West Point Police Department is asking the Council to surplus several items which includes 2003 Dodge 1500 pickup, 11 assorted monitors, 7 assorted televisions, 2 video monitors, 7 VCR's, 1 multiplexer for video recordings, 10 assorted printers, 6 assorted computer keyboards, 2 microwaves. These items will be placed on govdeals.com. The department also has 9 assorted computers which the hard drives will be cleaned or the computers will be destroyed. REZONE 208 SUNSET DR. PARCEL #094-4C-006-013

RESOLUTION FOR THE AMENDED AND RESTATED GAS SUPPLY CONTRACT

City Manager Ed Moon stated the Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia has requested all 77 members to pass a resolution to amend the Gas Supply Contract that will make each members ability to bring legal grievances against the authority/themselves more difficult. Councilmember Benjamin Wilcox had some concerns about limiting the City ability to seek legal action. City Manager stated the City Attorney Jeffrey Todd will be at the next work session to answer any legal questions concerning the request.

OTHER BUSINESS

City Manager Ed Moon gave updates on several projects. He stated the City is still working on acquiring the properties next Virginia Cook building. The Splash Park on 10th Street is officially closed for the year. The Splash Pad will remain open as long as weather permits. The after hour call center is on line. The City Staff is working out some minor details to aid in making the service more efficient.

Police Chief stated on September 17, 2016 the City of West Point Wellness Committee will sponsor a 5k and a 10k kayak race to help the Salvation Army with Christmas gifts for West Point residence. The Friends of West Point will be asked to sponsor a Formal and Fancy foot ware Gala to help the Salvation Army with the gifts also. Application to receive Christmas gifts will be held on September 29th and September 30th beginning at 9:00 at the Tech building on O.G. Skinner Drive.
